



Day of Prayer & Fasting / Friday, April 23, 2021

These are not to bind us in our praying but to aid us! We encourage you to share them with others and invite them to join with us in this concentrated, definite time of prayer. 1. Pray to the LORD for a divine intervention in the COVID crisis. (Zech. 4:6, Mark 13:20)

- a. Praise God that He is not fazed by any of this and He rules over the affairs of this world;
- b. Praise Him for His mighty power in the past and His unchanging omnipotence today to ‘stem the tide’ of this virus and turn the hearts of men back to Himself;
- c. Pray for those in authority (government, health etc.) that they would make right decisions and ultimately that they would turn and submit themselves to the Lordship of Christ.
- d. Pray for those suffering at this difficult time, not only from Covid, but with the increase of mental health issues etc. that they would know the Lord’s gracious intervention.

2. Pray for the work of the Gospel to continue to go forward (Matt. 24:14, Phil. 1:12)

- a. Praise God that lives are continuing to be impacted through the WORD wither online or in-person;
- b. Pray for a genuine work of conviction to fall and cause people to seek the Lord;
- c. Pray against any scheme of the enemy that would seek to thwart the work of the Gospel and blind the eyes of men and women to the truth; (2 Cor. 4:4)
- d. Pray that God’s people would be emboldened to ‘speak the truth in love’ and take every opportunity to ‘sow the seed’ of the Word.

3. Pray for our workers and the various needs in their communities (1 Cor. 15:58)

- a. Praise God for how He has continued to help and strengthen our FM workers across BC, Alberta, Ontario and Quebec;
- b. Pray that each worker and their families would be encouraged that their labour is not in vain in the Lord;
- c. Pray for renewed vision and strength, not only Spiritually, but also physically and mentally;
- d. Pray for wisdom in knowing what God would have them do and how they can continue to 'fulfil their calling'.
- e. Pray that the Lord would continue to provide financially for the needs of the work.

4. Pray for our Camp and Conference Centres – Falkland (BC) & Campbellville (ON)

- a. Pray for our Camp Manager in Campbellville (Myron Hoover) that he would know the Lord's gracious touch upon his body. **We are not dictating that the Lord MUST heal, but we are believing that the Lord CAN do it! (Ps. 107:19-21)*
- b. Pray for the ongoing needs at our camp centres and the financial constraints this has placed upon the work this year;
- c. Pray that the centres would soon be open to welcome more groups etc. and that the Summer programs would be able to run reaching kids & youth for Christ;
- d. Pray for the need for new Camp Managers at the Campbellville location in the very near future.

5. Pray for a mighty move of the Spirit of God across Canada

- a. Pray for a spirit of Prayer and Brokenness to sweep across the church and God's people today;
- b. Pray that genuine unity and fellowship would be evident among believers and that a dying world would see a living, loving Saviour through our witness;
- c. Pray for a genuine reviving of the hearts of God's people and a harvest of souls to be swept into the Kingdom.
- d. Pray that in all things God would receive All the Glory!
