We were recently able to join in an outdoor service in Barrie where we sang the very familiar hymn “Just as I am”. I was again amazed at the truth of the lyrics written so many years ago. Amazed that the Lord is still calling people to Himself and that as believers - though we truly have nothing to offer in and of ourselves - we have the immense privilege of playing a small part in that. Fall has proven to be a return to a more regular schedule for us; and although it is busy, we welcome the excitement this has brought! Several new areas of ministry have opened up for us. Mark’s preaching schedule continues to be very full, and he appreciates the opportunity to serve many different churches in our area in this way. Even in our full schedule here, we are thankful to have the flexibility to help out at the Campbellville camp centre as needed. We have just returned this week from our first “real” in-person ladies retreat in 2 years. It was a time of encouragement and blessing as April was able to hear what the Lord had laid on Isabel Bennett’s heart. Mark and John Bennett were able to step in and serve in the kitchen, which Mark really enjoyed. We are also looking forward to heading down to help at the Christmas in the Country banquets at the end of November. We are always very thankful for your prayers and support of our family and do not take them for granted.

WHATEVER HAPPENED TO PEACE ON EARTH?

Every time you sing the Christmas carol, “Hark the Herald Angels Sing,” you sing the words, “Peace on earth and mercy mild.” If you ever watch the news or read a newspaper, you may well be asking, “Whatever happened to peace on earth?” That’s a very good question. The terrorism danger for our world is high. One national correspondent expressed on television what a whole lot of people are feeling. He said, “I have never in my lifetime seen such a high degree of threat to our personal security.” Throw in dangers that you may be facing personally, such as medical or financial dangers, and you might wonder where the peace is that Christmas is supposed to be about.

The phrase “peace on earth” wasn’t invented by a greeting card company. It was part of the birth announcement of the first Christmas, delivered by angels from heaven to shepherds in the field watching over their sheep. Luke 2:13-14 from the Word of God says, “Suddenly a great company of the heavenly host appeared with the angel, praising God and saying, ‘Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to men on whom His favour rests.’”

In today’s dangerous and unpredictable world, where is that peace? It’s in the hearts of those who are ready for eternity, whenever it comes. They understand why the angel said that first Christmas, “Do not be afraid. I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. Today in the town of David a Saviour

has been born to you; He is Christ the Lord” (Luke 2:10-11). The announcement from heaven said that peace would be for those “on whom God’s favour rests.” The Bible makes it very clear that God’s favour rests on those who’s sins have been forgiven and totally erased from God’s Book. No religion can do that because no amount of doing good can erase the bad in your life. It took a Saviour...a rescuer.

If it could have been done without the death of the Son of God, you can be sure it would have been. Only a man could die for the sins of man, and only a man who was God could be the perfect sacrifice. He could barely find a place to be born as He came into the world He created. Many of us have kept the door of our heart closed to Him as surely as that innkeeper did centuries ago.

The peace we need most is peace with the God who made us, who we will meet when we die. Romans 5:1 says, “We have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.” When Jesus enters your life, the wall between you and God comes down forever and the war in your soul is over. Then there will be peace; peace that is recession-proof, divorce-proof, terror-proof, and death-proof.

You must first surrender the running of your own life because you were never supposed to and you were never made to. When you grab Jesus in total trust as your personal Rescuer from the guilt and penalty of your sin, the storm inside is replaced with His incredible peace. You will know you’re ready for eternity, whenever and however it comes.

There's not a better time to begin your relationship with Jesus Christ than today. Just tell Him, "Jesus, You died for me. I'm going to live for You." At Christmastime, we are celebrating when Jesus came to earth. Today, you can be celebrating the day He came into your life - the day the peace came!

Thank you all for your continued prayers! It was great to have been involved in three different day camps and two Vacation Bible schools this past Summer! It was great to have more of a “normal” Summer and to hear parents express how happy they were that something was happening for their children. This Fall started off with some changes in ministry here in Eastern Ontario. I have started teaching at St. Mary Magdalene Anglican Church youth group (Grades 7-10). We have 6 teens registered. We are just starting a seven-week series on basic Bible doctrines and also practicing Bible journaling. This is a creative way to interact with Scripture and think through what the verses mean, and what God is saying to you. Wilton has seen some changes to. We are no longer having a youth group as the Pastor and I believe this is something the community is not interested in. However, we have resumed kids club in person. We consistently have 4 children attending and one recently told me her grandmother reads to her every night from a devotional book for kids I had given her! Praise God!

As many of you know, I became involved in Online kids club at Westdale Park Free Methodist Church

in Sept 2020. We have moved to in-person and we average three children. This past weekend the church put on a family fall festival and two more children expressed interest in joining. Please pray these community children will be able to join and hear about God's great love for them! Verona Junior Youth has started up again with anywhere from 2-4 youth attending each week. One of the teens who comes is the one consistent teen that was coming to Wilton Youth. Since I started helping with youth in January 2019 we have watched as numbers fluctuated up and down. It is a very transient community but please pray with us as we discuss how to change things up to better reach the community. I am looking forward to some other Faith Mission Staff joining me in January to provide Children's programming for a Prayer Summit in my home Church (Bay Park Baptist). This will be held January 15-16, 2022. Please pray for the team as we put together a children's program so parents can take in the sessions.

There's been a lot of focus lately on DELIGHTING IN GOD'S WORD, from our Ladies Retreats, Marriage Retreat, and our church's adult studies. We NEED God's Word to live, know God, worship, make good decisions, and honor God in everything. As our Ladies Retreat speaker put it: "Discipline usually precedes Desire and Delight." If you're not reading the Bible daily; make a plan, and discipline yourself to spend time alone with God. What treasures of love, guidance, correction, and God's attributes we can discover! The desire and delight follows as we grow to LOVE God and His Word.

What a joy to watch women, and couples get excited about studying the Word! At our One-Day Ladies Retreats in the Fall, we encouraged each lady to spend 1/2 hour in the beautiful outdoors studying Psalm 1 on their own, but many spent their entire free time in the Word. At our October Marriage Enrichment Retreat, couples commented how they were challenged to read the

Bible and pray together, as some have not made the habit of doing this. And some are attempting to begin Family Devotions with their children as well. At our weekly Kids Klub in Falkland, Janice is often asked by children, "Is this story true?" as most have not heard anything from the Bible before. It is an absolute joy to teach these children, though the burden of responsibility is great!

As we look ahead, our rental schedule is getting very full with churches booking retreats for men, youth, young adults, pastors, and families. Spring to Fall 2022 is especially full with camps, retreats, and family reunions. We continue to seek God for new direction to meet emerging needs around us. One result is to plan a Family/Marriage Retreat weekend in May for couples who simply cannot find childcare, and as a result, can never attend a Marriage Retreat. It's not ideal, to work on your marriage with children under foot, but we expect it to meet a very specific need. It will require a lot of planning to incorporate meaningful childcare and family time into an already packed Marriage-focussed weekend. Please pray with us as we plan.

A lot of practical needs have been met around the camp lately. Everything is winterized, and we are so thankful for volunteer help to get rafters and a

new roof on Grace Place, so Kevin doesn't have to shovel snow off multiple times a winter!! Volunteers continue to keep the grounds beautiful with gardening, splitting wood, and gathering branches that tend to blow down regularly! We've been able to sell a donated quad to purchase another golf cart, which is of far greater use to us.

Please pray as we seek to gain favor with Interior Health as we need to replace our pool liner in the Spring, and the regulations are very limiting and costly. Also, we are in the process of developing a plan for a generator to run more necessities when we have prolonged power outages (which is fairly frequent!). And we have 2 furnaces to replace: 1 in Grace Place, and 1 in the gym. Thank you so much for your love, prayers, and support!
