- Creating a fun, enjoyable, and safe atmosphere for campers

Crew Member/Program*

- Assisting the Camp Managers in cleaning, preparation etc. during the camp program
- Support to the Program Director in setting up or taking down an activity
- Helping with small maintenance jobs
- Could involve serving in the kitchen, food prep etc.

Junior-leader*

- Assisting the camp counsellors and their groups in activities
- Joining with small group times and providing help to children in your group;
- Assisting with cleaning up, set up etc.
