God is faithful and as we continue to seek His will for us in Québec, He continues to lead us in His ways. Rob continues to serve on the board at Camp des Iles. The camp directors resigned at the end of 2022 and there were many guestions about what would happen this summer and whether the camp would stay open. But God...I love those words...called a couple to stand in the gap and there will be 4 weeks of day camps taking place this summer, two in English followed by two in French. We are planning to teach during the chapel times for the first English week and we are looking forward to what God has in store. A new door that God has opened for Rob and a few others from our church, is to serve alongside our pastor, who is a chaplain at a maximum-security prison. This has been such an encouragement as there are many inmates who have come to Christ in prison and many others who are seeking and sensitive to the gospel. He is also planning to start a Bible study with a young man who formerly attended one of our youth groups and has recently moved a few minutes from where we

are now living. Please pray for this young man. He made a profession of faith years ago and still believes, but he is not currently walking with the Lord and is finding it hard to commit his life to Him. We need the Lord to do a work in his heart that only He can do!

God has opened up a new door of service for Debra as well. She has the privilege of mentoring one of our former youths. She is currently living with us, while she is enrolled in full-time French studies to learn the language. She is a real blessing and is a missionary in her school. Many people have been asking her questions and they are wanting to know more and are willing to come to a Bible study, which is planned to commence in early May. There are 3 ladies that are planning to attend, each in a different season of life ranging from early 20s to late 40s. We are praying that God would soften their hearts to be sensitive to His truths. During this new season, Debra is currently organizing our summer program which is already filled up for the summer. We are praying that God would guide the preparations, but that He would also be preparing hearts - that this would be a summer marked by God's visible grace seen in the transforming of lives!

EVANGELISM & REVIVAL: IS THERE A DIFFERENCE?

These days there is a word being thrown around which is causing much confusion in regard to its content. There are so many different ideas around this word that it is sometimes used totally out of context. The word is - Revival! Please allow me to throw some light on this word, and what it is not!

Firstly, evangelism has unfortunately been linked to the word Revival. My friends, evangelism is <u>not</u> Revival. Many good intentioned churches have joined these two ministries together with a hope of a great outreach. Unfortunately, it has in some cases caused and inflicted damage to genuine 'Prayer for Revival' ministries.

Our dear friend Billy Graham preached to thousands in evangelistic crusades but however effective the results were, it was not a Revival.

Let me try to explain it this way. Church evangelism is the expression brought about by the cooperation of both a human and divine effort. However, Revival is an absolute and total movement of God. It is a powerful, spiritual atmosphere created among His own people. This is a God thing! Something only God does and only God can. One Pastor said it this way, "Evangelism is the work His people do for God, but Revival is the work God does for His people".

This word Revival wears many hats and has many different definitions according to our own ideas. One illustration I really like is David trying to stand up and walk in Saul's armor, it just didn't fit – it wasn't' being used for it's intended purpose! (1 Samuel 17:38-39) My friends, the basic idea contained in this word, Revival, is the return of something to its true purpose.

G. Campbell Morgan said it this way, "Revival is the re-animation of the life of the believer - not the unregenerate person - as they are dead in sin." My friends, there can only be revival where there is life to revive. So, revival then is for the Christian. (Ephesians 2:1-3) My friends, sinners don't need revival, they need a new heart, they need salvation! (Romans 10:9-11)

Revival then is the Christian church turning back, again, to their God given norm. And what is that? Nothing less than a Holy Spirit of Pentecost again!

In the book of Acts 3:19-29 Peter made it clear that when people repented of their sin this would be followed by something wonderful. That there would be times of refreshing that shall come from the presence of the Lord. My friends, is this not what we want?! A spiritual refreshing from the presence and power of the Lord! A true revival where Christ's powerful presence is manifested amongst us! That's a picture of Pentecost!

Just try to imagine Acts 3. Except for the ministry of Jesus, no prophet had spoken to the nation of Israel for 400 years! Spiri-

tually speaking I would think they were at an all time low, destitute, depressed, broken, given up. But then the Holy Spirit came! Pentecost was birthed. Thousands were brought into a new relationship with God. It was a time of refreshing from the Lord, my friends. Every revival contains some features of the day of Pentecost, because Pentecost is God's plan of blessing His church. It brought with it a glorious, powerful, spiritual shaking and awakening for both the churched and the unchurched. O, Lord, do it again – yes do it again!

In closing, please don't be intimidated by those who tell us that Pentecost was just a one time event. There will always be present in

revivals the ingredients of Pentecost. Always the conviction of sin, pride, selfishness and self guilt. But always aiming for great joy, freedom, healings and the amazing supernatural presence of God.

I wonder if the next revival will contain all of the glorious ingredients that Pentecost experienced... I hope so, don't you? (2 Chronicles 7:11-16)
